The integration of usage-based insurance, autonomous driving technologies, data analytics, predictive modelling, and cybersecurity measures is revolutionizing the claims landscape.

The claims resolution process aims to provide equitable compensation, balancing the interests of all parties involved and contributing to a smoother functioning of the overall motor insurance ecosystem.

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College of Insurance has designed this two-day training program on Motor Own Damage (OD) and Third-Party (TP) Claims with the primary objective of equipping the participants with comprehensive knowledge and practical skills required to handle motor insurance claims efficiently.
