



Help Manual for Credits for Prior Learning (Exemption in Professional exams)

➤ Criteria

Only Registered candidates can apply for exemption.

- I) Candidate who **do not have III Registration id** (The **new candidate**) -
Has to register as a member of I.I.I. by paying the registration fee of Rs. 700 plus applicable taxes map the profile as given in Examinations- help Manual – New candidate, then can apply for exemption from exam registration- Paper enrolment – Apply for Exemption.
- II) Candidate who **having III registration id** (The **Already registered candidate**) -
No need to pay registration fees, this candidate can continue with their existing III login from Exam registration- Paper enrolment- Apply for Exemption.

➤ Information

- The Credits for Prior Learning is available to the III Professional examination registered candidates up to Associateship Level only in the professional examination subjects as per eligibility criteria given on the III web portal in the tab-

Examinations- Examination handbook->Chapter no. 9- Credits for prior learning.

Details are given i.e. Institute wise or University wise and for which subject's exemption will be granted and how much total credit points will be allotted to the candidates after approval from III on web portal.

- The candidates are eligible to apply for Credits for Prior Learning who has scored 50% and above marks in each subject of exemption from their respective Institute/ University.
Also candidates should apply immediately or if they failed to apply immediately then they can apply within 5 years from passing their qualified examination. After 5 years candidates cannot apply for exemption and even they apply, their application will be rejected. This validity of 5 years of exemption applying criteria is not applicable for Chartered Accountants, Cost Accountants.
- The list of Institutes / universities, qualifications and the fee structure is available on III website in tab-> **Examinations ->Credits for Prior Learnings-> Exemption Fee Structure**

EXEMPTION FEE STRUCTURE

The candidate have to register as a member of I.I.I. by paying the Registration Fees of Rs. 700 plus applicable taxes through online mode.

The exemption fee is to be paid through online mode alongwith applicable taxes. The help manual for how to apply for exemption through online mode is available under Help Desk menu.

Steps to Apply for Exemption

- Login to I.I.I. website i.e. www.insuranceinstituteofindia.com
- Exam Registration -> Paper Enrollment -> Apply for Exemption
- The registration id and name will displayed automatically.
- Select Institute Name & qualification
- After selecting qualification the details of subjects to be exempted and diploma for the particular Institute and qualification will displayed.

If candidate selects wrong qualification, then application will be rejected after verification.

- For all candidates Upload all self-attested documents in single pdf i.e. all semester wise mark sheets, and final passing certificate.

And in addition to above,

In case of ICAI and ICWA candidates, membership certificate and if candidate has not applied within 5 years then CPE proof of minimum 20 hours proof is compulsory to be uploaded on III website.

- Select Month and year of passing the exam. For e.g. If candidate has completed diploma/qualification in March 2023, then select Month as March and Year as 2023.
- Payment details will be automatically displayed after selecting the institute and qualification.
- If do you have GST No. then click on YES and enter your GSTIN number otherwise click on No.
- After entering all the data click on payment.
